Meeting Minutes — June 29, 2026

1. Call to Order

Review of the prior week's meeting minutes was waived until the following week.

2. Committee Updates

Treasury

The group reported ongoing nonprofit-related expenses and current account balances. Donations continue to support the organization's work, and additional deposits are scheduled.

Fundraising

The committee discussed plans for the Battle of the Bands fundraiser on August 23 at Hoftstown Winery, including set lengths, transition acts, and possible volunteer support. Members also reviewed the upcoming bake sale on July 5 and discussed additional fundraising ideas such as bingo, Venmo donations, donation jars, and PO boxes for contributions.

Members also discussed the importance of maintaining strong financial controls to protect the organization's nonprofit status.

3. Old Business

501(c)(4) Formation

The group reviewed progress on incorporation and nonprofit paperwork, including IRS filing steps and approval of bylaws.

Attorney Update

The group confirmed attorney representation for nonprofit and IRS-related work. A motion was approved to move forward with legal support for the organization's status and compliance needs.

Radio Advertising

The group reported remaining radio advertisement slots and discussed using media outreach to promote the July 21 town hall meeting.

Website Update

The organization's domain has been secured, and website development is underway. An email address has also been established for online accounts.

4. Information Updates

Ordinance and County Activity

Members reviewed updates on the Granville ordinance process, including planning commission feedback and the upcoming July 15 township supervisor meeting. The county ordinance remains under review, with other municipalities expected to follow county-level guidance where applicable.

5. Strategy Discussion

Sign Campaign

The group discussed the free sign campaign, including new sign styles, remaining inventory, and pricing for additional signs. Members agreed to continue evaluating the cheapest option while checking quality.

Outreach

Members discussed possible public outreach efforts ahead of the July 21 town hall, including a travel sign display, a calling and letter-writing campaign, and broader public engagement.
