

NO DATA CENTER IN MIFFLIN COUNTY GROUP

Meeting Minutes — July 6, 2026

1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 6:03 PM, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. Guest Discussion: Mifflin County Commissioners

Mifflin County Commissioners Kevin Kodish and Noah Wise attended the meeting and shared concerns regarding potential data center development in the county. Both expressed opposition to data centers and emphasized agricultural preservation, local impacts, and responsiveness to community concerns.

Discussion also included ongoing county-level ordinance work, concerns about electricity and water usage, and the need for clear local review of future development proposals.

Commissioners stated they would not speak on behalf of Commissioner Rob Postal.

Commissioners departed at 6:39 PM.

3. Approval of Prior Minutes

A motion to approve the prior meeting minutes was made by JT and seconded by Charli. The motion carried.

4. Meeting Structure and Decorum

Members discussed an updated meeting format under which every other meeting will function as a board meeting. The group also reviewed a revised speaking process to improve order and participation during meetings.

5. Committee Updates

Treasury

The group reported that a monthly treasurer's report will be provided going forward, including full line-item reporting. Reported totals were \$1,967 in income and \$274.87 in expenses.

A motion to accept the treasury report was made by Nate and seconded by JT. The motion carried by verbal vote.

Fundraising

The group reviewed recent and upcoming fundraising efforts, including a bake sale, the Marianna's fundraiser, and additional event concepts under consideration. Ideas discussed included Goose Day fundraising activities, a mums sale, and possible raffle-related efforts pending licensing and partner coordination.

6. Old Business

Organizational Status

An update was provided on continued work toward formalizing 501(c)(4) status. Insurance options are also being reviewed.

Website

Work continues on the organization's website, including general information, donations, FAQ content, and opposition-related material. The website can be accessed at NDCMC.org

Sign Campaign

The group reported the purchase of 150 signs through designated donations and discussed volunteer support, placement strategy, and sign tracking.

Legislative Update

Members discussed the status of legislative activity and encouraged continued outreach to state lawmakers.

7. New Business

Postcard and Media Outreach

The group discussed a handwritten postcard campaign and additional public messaging through local media. Members confirmed 30 radio advertisement slots across three local stations at \$11 per announcement.

Municipal Outreach

Members also discussed sending letters to local townships, boroughs, and municipalities to invite attendance at the upcoming town hall meeting.
